HUDSON VALLEY * WEST POINT ACADEMY MUSEUM * BERKSHIRE Sunday - Oct. 9 Enjoy the beautiful Hudson River Valley scenery this morning as we make our way to "West Point", our nation's most famous Military Academy, established in 1778. You'll visit the West Point Museum, store and Visitors Center, with great views of the Hudson River. This afternoon we visit the famous Norman Rockwell Museum. This museum houses the world's largest and most significant collection of original Rockwell art. Highlights include enduring favorites from Rockwell's Saturday Evening Post covers, the powerful Four Freedoms, and the nostalgic Stockbridge Main Street at Christmas. The Norman Rockwell Archive contains more than 100,000 photographs, letters and other rare mementos. We stay in picturesque Berkshire tonight.
