Day One - February 29

SALT LAKE CITY * HOUSTON (IAH)

Your South American adventure begins as you depart for incredible Rio de Janeiro! We will meet up with tour members flying from other cities in Houston. Boarding begins this afternoon for our non-stop flight to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

Day Two - March 1 RIO DE JANEIRO * CORCOVADO MOUNTAIN * CHRIST THE REDEEMER

After arrival, proceed to our Hilton Copacabana Beach hotel where we will enjoy a nice welcome breakfast with our group. After, we are transported by our deluxe motor coach to Cosme Velho where we board our cogwheel train through the **Tijuca Forest** up the **Corcovado Mountain**. Enjoy views of the lush rainforest before arriving at the top to visit the Christ the Redeemer statue – one of the world's man-made wonders. From one of Rio's most privileged belvederes, appreciate the panoramic views of the city and its surroundings. We make our way back down for a typical Brazilian barbeque lunch at a local restaurant. Check into your Hilton Copacabana Beach hotel for the next threenights.

RIO DE JANEIRO * CITY TOUR * METROPOLITAN CATHEDRAL Day Three - March 2

Today we visit Rio's downtown area on a guided city tour. Walk along the cobblestone streets in old Rio and see the beautiful architecture all around. See the National Library, the Municipal Theatre, the Candelaria Church, and the Cultural Center. Then, step inside the Metropolitan Cathedral and appreciate its unique architecture and beautiful interior, with floor-to-ceiling-stained glass windows. After a rest break at the hotel, depart for a typical Brazilian style dinner. (B,D)

RIO DE JANEIRO * SUGAR LOAF MOUNTAIN Day Four – March 3

Enjoy a buffet breakfast this morning before our visit to the beautiful Sugar Loaf Mountain. This morning, we drive to the Urca neighborhood and start our visit to the iconic Sugar Loaf Mountain. You'll enjoy the view as we travel by glass cable cars through the lush vegetation. From the top, enjoy spectacular views of Rio de Janeiro. Later, we have a group lunch before returning to your Copacabana Beach hotel. The afternoon and evening are yours to enjoy! Maybe walk along Copacabana Beach, take a swim in the ocean, or visit the many shops right around your hotel.

RIO DE JANEIRO * MANAUS Day Five - March 4

We say goodbye to the white sandy beaches of Rio de Janeiro and hello to the Amazon Rainforest! After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight to Manaus, the capital of the Amazon region. Upon arrival in Manaus, we are transferred to our deluxe hotel with sightseeing along the way. Enjoy the beautiful surroundings of your hotel. (B)

Day Six - March 5 MANAUS * AMAZON RIVER * EVENING BOAT RIDE

After breakfast, we depart Manaus and travel to our Amazon Lodge, right on the Amazon River. This afternoon we visit a "caboclo" home. Take a motorized canoe and learn about the local indigenous communities, traditions, customs, the rubber boom, and how to prepare a typical cassava meal. We have dinner at our lodge before an evening boat ride. Experience the rainforest like never before! Listen for all the sounds of the rainforest as we try to spot alligators and other nocturnal animals. If lucky, our local Amazon quide will try to catch a small alligator for us to view up close and personal. Learn about the reptile's habitat, hunting methods, and biology. (B,L,D)

AMAZON RIVER * "MEETING OF THE WATERS" Day Seven - March 6

Enjoy breakfast at our lodge before a full day tour. Embark on a double-decker boat that navigates down the Rio Negro. Pass by the shores of Manaus and see the city's landmarks such as the Amazona Theater, the city port, and typical stilt houses. Arrive at the "Meeting of the waters" where two-colored rivers meet, keep an eye out for the famous Amazon River dolphins that live and play here. The two-colored waters flow together for about 7-miles without mixing. The phenomenon happens due to differences in temperature, density, and speed of both rivers. The spectacular merge of the Rio Negro and the Solimoes Rivers form the Amazon River that goes all the way to the Atlantic Ocean. Return this evening for an incredible dinner at our Amazon Lodge (B,L,D)

AMAZON * MONKEY FOREST * FISHING TOUR Day Eight – March 7

After breakfast this morning, we visit "Monkey Forest", a project created in 1991 that offers facilities for wild animals. Here, a team of veterinarians and biologists rescue animals from illegal commerce, give them shelter, and help with their rehabilitation and eventual re-introduction into nature. Learn more about the animals and project during this special visit. You'll also get up close for photos of the animals in a natural and safe setting. After lunch, we depart by boat for an exciting fishing tour. Try your hand at fishing for Piranhas, if you catch them, we'll cook them for dinner!

Day Nine – March 8 <u>MANAUS * IGUAZU</u>

Today we say goodbye to the Amazon and make our way to Iguazu for another incredible highlight of the tour. We are transferred by our deluxe motor coach to the local airport for our flight from Manus to **Foz do Iguassu**. Upon arrival in Iguazu, we are met by our local guide and transferred to our deluxe luxury lodge for the next three nights. After settling into your room, we'll enjoy a typical Argentinean dinner as a group.

Day Ten – March 9 IGUAZU FALLS - BRAZILIAN SIDE * BOAT RIDE INTO THE FALLS

Breakfast this morning before departing to the **Brazilian National Park for Iguassu Falls**. Drive through the National Park until we reach the entrance for the **Brazilian side of the falls**. Today is a highlight of the tour as you walk along the many pathways with beautiful vegetation, butterflies, and of course incomparable views of Iguazu Falls. Follow the path that leads you to the amazing panoramic view of the **Devil's Throat**. You'll also enjoy spectacular views of the **Two Sisters Falls**, **Bozzeti Falls**, **the Superior Circuit**, and **San Martin Island**. After a delicious **group lunch**, it's time for a fast and fun adventure, a **jetboat ride into Iguazu Falls**! See the falls like never before as our **jetboat** takes us up the river and into the falls! This is a once-in-a-lifetime experience you won't forget! **(B,L)**

Day Eleven – March 10 <u>IGUAZU FALLS - ARGENTINEAN SIDE</u>

Now that you've seen the Brazilian side of the falls, it's time to experience what the Argentinean side has to offer! Travel through **Iguazu National Park in Argentina**, before boarding the **train** taking us to the **Upper Circuit**. Enjoy the scenery, nature, river, and spectacular views of the many falls. Arrive at **Devil's Throat**, the park's most impressive and immense waterfalls. Measuring 492 feet long and 262 feet high; its horseshoe shape creates a stunning waterfall you will remember forever. Then, we'll walk the **Lower Circuit** for more incredible views of the falls. There is nothing quite like Iguazu Falls anywhere in the world and now you've experienced both sides for the **complete visit**. Return to our hotel this afternoon. Maybe swim in the two-tiered infinity pool, walk along the jungle pathways in hopes of spotting the Toucan bird, or simply rest and relax in your luxury hotel.

Day Twelve – March 11 PUERTO IGUAZU * BUENOS AIRES

Day Thirteen – March 12 <u>BUENOS AIRES * RECOLETA CEMETERY * CITY SIGHTSEEING</u>

Today is all about the "Land of Tango"! We have a **guided tour** taking us to all the special points of interest in the Capital city. First, we visit **Plaza de Mayo**, where the Government House and the first City Hall are located. Step inside the **Metropolitan Cathedral** where its towering ceilings, striking stained glass, marble columns, and paintings are a sight to see. Afterwards, we visit **La Boca** and its famous "**Caminito**" street. See the painted houses as we walk along the colorful streets filled with souvenir shops and Tango dancers. Next, it's off to the beautiful parks and green spaces of **Palermo**, as we make our way back to the **Recoleta district**. We have a special **group lunch** today before enjoying a guided visit of the **Recoleta Cemetery**. Founded in 1822, the cemetery is one of the most prominent in the world; many national heroes, presidents, well-known writers, scientists, and artists are buried here. See its ornate mausoleums, sculptures, and vaults made by local and international artists and visit **Eva "Evita" Peron's grave**. Enjoy the evening from your centrally located hotel. (**B,L**)

Day Fourteen – March 13 SAN ANTONIO DE ARECO – LA BAMBA DE ARECO

We leave the city of Buenos Aires and drive to **San Antonio de Areco**, the heart of the "**Gaucho**" traditions in the "**Pampas**" region. Upon arrival, **walk around the small village's cobblestoned streets** and appreciate its quaint historical center. Also known as the "Cradle of Tradition" the colonial town was founded over 280 years ago and is filled with old bars (pulperias) and artisan shops with over 30 silversmiths. Visit **Draghi's Silversmith Museum** and meet with an artisan who will tell you all about their trade and family's fascinating story. Then, continue towards "**La Bamba de Areco" ranch**. Dating back to 1830, it is located on the Royal Road that links Buenos Aires to the north of the country. One of the oldest Argentinean colonial-style ranches, it is deeply rooted in Argentine and "**gaucho**" **history**. Enjoy some free time to **horseback ride** or relax at the ranch's facilities. Then, enjoy a **typical BBQ known as "Asado"** before returning to Buenos Aires and your hotel. (**B,L**)



Day Fifteen – March 14 TIGRE * PARANA DELTA BOAT TOUR * INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT

This morning we will visit **Tigre**, a popular getaway location that boats many summer homes as well as yacht and rowing clubs. Take a **boat excursion** along the **Parana Delta** and its channels, rivers, streams, and numerous islands. After a fun filled day, we are transferred to the Buenos Aires International airport to check-in for our international flight back home.
